

Letter of Guarantee

Best Sanitizers, Inc. certifies that ALPET D2 complies with earlier USDA guidelines for **D2**Sanitizers for all surfaces not always requiring a rinse: for use as a sanitizer in food processing and food handling areas in official establishments operating under the Federal Meat and Poultry Inspection Program. This certification is based on a review by Best Sanitizers, Inc. establishing that ALPET D2 meets current EPA, FDA and USDA requirements for Food Contact Surface Sanitizers. ALPET D2 is formulated to meet 21 CFR 178.1010 subsection (b)(17). ALPET D2 is used undiluted and should be dispensed from Best Sanitizers, Inc. dispensers. ALPET D2 is registered with the US EPA, and is produced under conditions meeting applicable regulations. ALPET D2 is registered with NSF (Category Code D2: NSF registration number 126509. When used following label instructions ALPET D2 is safe and effective as a Sanitizer and will not adulterate food products when used following label directions. These EPA approved label directions allow for ALPET D2 to be used to preclean surfaces and for surfaces that cannot be washed and rinsed to be cleaned in a appropriate fashion before application of this product.

EXPIRATION DATING:

Best Sanitizers, Inc. expiration dates our product for customers operating under HACCP guidelines. We are not required by EPA to expiration date our products.

D2 Sanitizers for all surfaces not always requiring a rinse

Before using these compounds, food products and packaging materials must be removed form the room or carefully protected. A potable water rinse is not required following use of these compounds for sanitizing previously cleaned hard surfaces provided that the surfaces are adequately drained before contact with food so that little of no residue remains which can adulterate or have a deleterious effect on edible products. These compounds may be used for microbial control on ceilings, floors, and walls at concentrations higher than those allowed for sanitizing food contact surfaces with out a potable water rinse unless, in the opinion of the Inspector in Charge, such use may result in contamination of food products. A potable water rinse is required following use of these compounds under conditions other than those stated above. The compounds must always be used at dilutions and according to applicable directions provided on the EPA registered Label

NOTE italicized section is not applicable since ALPET D2 is not diluted before use.

The final granting of authorization for the proposed use of such compounds is the responsibility of the Inspector in Charge of the official plant. Best Sanitizers, Inc. will provide technical assistance on request.
